Step 1. Enroll Online

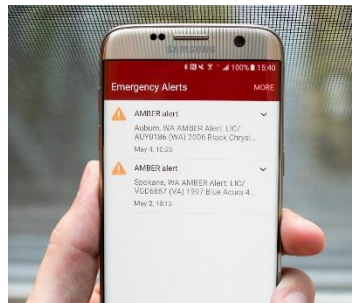
Go to www.panhandlealert.org and enter the required information and how you want to be reached

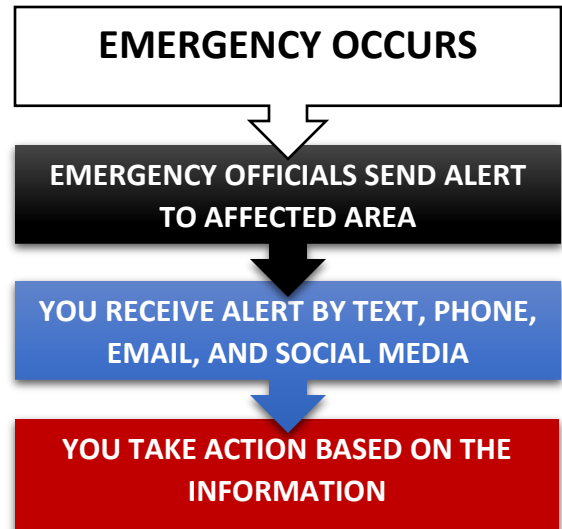

What is Panhandle Alert?

Panhandle Alert is the region's official emergency notification system. **Panhandle Alert** is a FREE service that allows you to sign up online to receive customized alerts by text message, email, voice message and on social media (Facebook and Twitter).

What Types of Alerts Will I Receive?

EMERGENCY ALERTS are sent when there is a significant risk to life or property at any time of the day or night. **COMMUNITY NOTIFICATIONS** are customizable and are only sent during the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 9:00 p.m. They include notifications about severe weather, safety, health, utility service disruptions, major traffic incidents, changes in government services due to weather or holidays, etc.
